 - c. Get up when the alarm sounds OR Snooze button is your friend
 - d. Star Wars OR Star Trek?
 - e. Is there another "controversial" topic you find yourself on one side of?
- 2. Who is the original intended audience of this parable? What is Jesus trying to communicate to this audience?
- 3. Based on the learning from this passage, what is the best way to approach prayer with God?
- 4. What would your prayer life look like if you began every prayer with the same words that came from the mouth of the tax collector? "God have mercy on me a Sinner."

5.	What does it look like to approach prayer from a position of humility? What does
	it look like to approach life from a position of humility?

- 6. What do you think this passage of scripture can teach us about how to approach the communion table?
- 7. I don't think the point of this passage from Luke is to identify a particular group of people that are doing it wrong. If the pharisee began his work as a religious leader in the right place, what do you think led him down the path to becoming self-righteous? How do you think we can avoid that kind of "missing the mark" in our own faith filled lives?
