



## RENEW COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Please note that this represents our best efforts to follow all federal, state and local guidelines, and may be updated at any time as new information becomes available. Our desire is to provide a safe environment for our kids, so that they may experience the fellowship and community that they so desperately need right now.

- Students and parents are asked to arrive no earlier than 6:20PM, and to please be ready for pickup by 8PM. Anyone arriving before 6:20PM will be directed to remain in their vehicle until we are ready to receive students at 6:20PM.
- We would discourage students from sharing rides with anyone not in their immediate family.
- While on campus, students will be discouraged from having any form of physical contact with others (high fives, hugs, etc.).
- At 6:20PM, we will open outdoor check-in for RENEW. Before joining the service, students will need to answer a couple of questions regarding their current state of health. Also, leaders will take student's temperature. If they have an elevated temperature or have recently been ill, they will be advised to not join the group and return home instead.
- For the foreseeable future, the RENEW gathering will take place entirely outdoors. Our games, teaching and small groups will all happen outside, on the MPC campus. The main gathering will happen on the patio area just outside of the main sanctuary with chairs spaced out 6' away from each other. When the "big group" time has finished, and it's time for students to move into small groups, students will take their chairs with them to pre-designated areas for small groups. These small group circles will be marked out in advance with places for the chairs to go, to make sure that all chairs are 6' apart.
- During RENEW, all leaders and students will be required to wear masks and to maintain 6' social distancing at all times.
- For the foreseeable future, corporate worship (singing) will not be part of our weekly gathering.
- Bathrooms with outdoor access (off Wilkinson Hall) will be available, but will be limited to one person in the bathroom at a time.
